
Thank you for presenting your seminar at Diploma Course in May-June 2004. I have summarized the 2003 and 2004 evaluations so you might have an idea of how residents perceived the seminar. The evaluations are on a 4-point scale from Outstanding (which I have given a numerical value of 4), Satisfactory (3), Borderline (2) and Unsatisfactory (1). The 2003 and 2004 evaluation forms are slightly different in dimensions measured, with "Achievement of Learning Objectives" being added in 2004.

Residents commented that the seminar was interesting, useful, clear and comprehensive. They pointed out that sleep disorders were done in detail but suggested some time limitation on this because anxiety disorders were not covered. Whereas some suggested greater encouragement of resident participation, others found it excellent. Some mentioned that case vignettes and treatment strategies would be helpful. Handouts were described as excellent.
